At BRACE we serve the following groups of students:

Outreach Students—in person and online learning with teachers, located at the North Door 6205-48Ave (ECCHS—McCleary Wing). We serve learners grades 10 and up who are wanting to complete their diploma, or maybe upgrade a course for post-secondary requirements.

Shared Students—online learning for high school students enrolled at a high school in BRSD, but need a course or two that they are unable to receive at their local school due to timetabling issues etc.

Online Students 5-9—online programming is provided to students in grades 5-9 who are able to work independently. This is offered for core subjects only.

Home School—parent led education for students supported by BRSD.

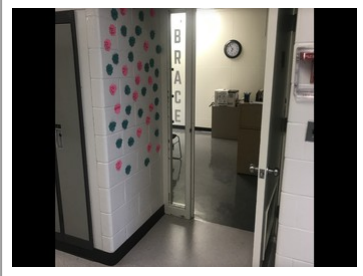
We also support students at the Women's Shelter and The Learning Together Program.

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GRADES 5-9 STUDENTS
